DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

Baldwin Wallace Conservatory of Music is located in two buildings. The recently remodeled Boesel Musical Arts Center (BMAC) and the original building, Kulas Musical Arts Building (Kulas). Lindsay Crossman Chapel (Chapel), located directly across the street from BMAC, will be used for auditions.

- Boesel Musical Arts Building (BMAC) is located at 49 Seminary Street, Berea, OH 44017.
- BMAC is the main entrance to the conservatory off Seminary Street.
- Kulas Musical Arts Building is located at 96 Front Street, Berea, OH 44017
- Lindsay-Crossman Chapel is located at 56 Seminary Street, Berea, OH, 44017
- Street Parking is available on Seminary, Front, Beech and surrounding areas.
- Public Parking is available next to BMAC, Coe Lake and nearby Giant Eagle. Interactive Map

REGISTRATION AND AUDITION VENUES

- Registration for teachers is in the lobby of Boesel Musical Arts Center (BMAC).
- Students do not need to register upon arrival.
- All auditions will be held in the BMAC, Kulas and Lindsay-Crossman Chapel.
- 27 practice rooms are available in the lower and main level of BMAC.
- Signs will be posted on available practice rooms.
- The announcement of Finalists and the Winners' Recital will be held in the Gamble Auditorium, Kulas Building.

STAFF ACCOMPANIST REHEARSALS

• For those students who have hired an official NATS staff pianist, a separate schedule of student rehearsal times and locations will be emailed to the address associated with those students' registration.

AUDITION RULES & TIME LIMITS

Lower categories

- Students in High School and lower categories may sing their pieces in any order.
- Upon entering the room, they should announce their name and the order of their selections.
- o If the total singing time exceeds the time limit, the judges will stop them.
- o Category time limits can be found here.

Upper categories

- o Students in Upper Categories will begin with the piece of their choosing.
- The judges will then ask for any piece from their list to be heard in part or in full.
- Judges may choose to stop singers with longer repertoire selections to allow time for other pieces.
- This format replicates an authentic professional audition experience.
- o Category time limits can be found here.

REPERTOIRE AND REPERTOIRE CHANGES

- The submitted repertoire has been approved and vetted following submission according to each category's requirements.
- If you wish to change a student's repertoire, you may do so by emailing me (swallin@bw.edu) with any changes for approval **before 6:00 PM on Tuesday, October 18**.
- This is a firm deadline.
- If the change satisfies the repertoire requirements, I will make the change(s) in the online system.
- Once you receive confirmation, you will need to print the revised judging forms for your students by returning to www.nats.org
- Scroll down and click the green "NATS Auditions Registration" button.
- Then, simply click the orange "Print Judging Forms" button.

COPYRIGHT AND CUTS

- NATS <u>does allow</u> the usage of IPads. Pianists should play from legally downloaded scores or from original scores. Students and pianists should be prepared to show proof if asked.
- Legally downloaded scores may include music purchased from a music website, directly from the composer, or from a public domain site such as IMSLP or other.

AUDITION SCHEDULES

- You will receive emails containing your students' audition times and your judging schedule with categories, times, and room numbers.
- Each pianist will receive an email containing their schedule for the day complete with teacher name (with contact information), student name (with contact information), audition time, room number, and the approved repertoire.

JUDGING FORMS

- <u>Teachers must print their students' judging forms</u> by logging in to <u>www.nats.org</u> via the "Member Login" icon in the upper right corner.
- Scroll down and click the green "NATS Auditions Registration" button.
- Click on the blue button "My Registration: Ohio -2022 Ohio NATS Student Auditions"
- Then, click the orange "Print Judging Forms" button.
- Students must bring three copies of the official adjudication forms <u>printed by you</u> from the natsauditions.com site with the repertoire printed on them.
- Please bring an extra set of forms with you.
- Handwritten or blank forms will not be accepted.

AUDITION RESULTS

- Finalists for each category will be posted in the BMAC and KULAS lobbies, on the Ohio NATS website (ohio NATS website (ohionats.org) and on our Facebook page (NATS Ohio Chapter).
- Be sure to "like" us on Facebook so the results will post in your newsfeed!

HONORS RECITAL

- First Place Winners' in each category perform 1 selection at the Honors Recital immediately following the announcements. An additional prize is then awarded by the remaining judges.
- We strongly encourage both teachers and students to remain for the Honors Recital. It is important that we support and celebrate our students and colleagues.
- It is a great opportunity for students to hear peer singers and learn new repertoire.
- This educational experience can provide great inspiration to our students!
